ELIGIBILITY FOR ATHLETES

Registered member in good standing with any of the following organization:

United States Judo Federation, Inc. (USJF), United States Judo, Inc. (USJI), United States Judo Association, Inc. (USJA). All contestants must present a current and valid registration card.

Athletes from foreign countries must present a letter from their country's federation stating that they are a member in good standing and have the Federation's permission to compete. Proof of Citizenship must be presented at Tournament Check-in. Passports are mandatory for all citizens of countries other than the United States.

Competition Method

The standard ("true") Double Elimination System with winner's and loser's brackets will be used. The winner of the loser's bracket will compete against the winner of the winner's bracket for 1st and 2nd place. The first one of these two contestants to have two (2) losses will be placed second; the other will be placed first. The loser of the loser's bracket will be placed 3rd.

Age Categories of Competition and Weight Divisions

All divisions are determined at time of weigh-ins and are subject to modification based on entries. Each skill, gender and age category will be separated into weight divisions, generally: light, middle and heavy.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to make all final decisions regarding this event.

Rules

All matches will be conducted using the current IJF contest Rules with the following modifications:

NO Shime-Waza (Chokes) under 13 year old. NO Shime-Waza in any junior novice division.

NO Kansestu-Waza (Arm locks) in senior novice division. NO Kansestu-Waza under 17 years old.

SENIOR BROWN and BLACK

1. Match Time: 4 minutes
2. Shime-waza (chokes) allowed
3. Kansetsu-waza (arm locks) allowed (Unlimited Golden score)

- **Individual Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze (one bronze) medals will be awarded for first, second and third places for all divisions
- All medal winners MUST be in regulation judo uniform or team sweats (track suit) to accept any and all awards.
- **White Judo Gi is Mandatory:** Contestants are encouraged to bring their own blue and white belts. Blue and white belts will be available at the tournament; **Blue Judo Gis are optional for blue side only.**
